

Start your adventure in Fairbanks, Alaska and travel southbound to Denali National Park, Anchorage, and Seward. You'll board your cruise in Seward and sail south through Glacier Bay National Park and the Inside Passage with stops at Haines, Juneau and Ketchikan. Your final destination will be Vancouver, British Columbia.

TRIP DETAILS:

Monday, May 21, 2012 – Fairbanks, AK – Arrive in Fairbanks – meet your Tour Concierge and overnight in a deluxe hotel.

Tuesday, May 22, 2012 – Fairbanks to Denali National Park – After a transfer to the Rail Depot you'll depart Fairbanks (8:15 am) via the McKinley Explorer's luxury glass-domed railcars for your trip to Denali (12:15 pm). After transferring to your hotel, you'll have the afternoon at leisure to explore!

Wednesday, May 23, 2012 – Denali National Park - This morning you'll board the Tundra Wilderness Tour for 6 hours of breathtaking scenery and wildlife viewing. Watch for moose, caribou and if you're lucky you might see a grizzly (all from the safety of your tour vehicle)!!!! After the tour you'll have the rest of the evening at leisure.

Thursday, May 24, 2012 – Denali National Park – Anchorage - Enjoy a leisurely morning on your own, then you'll reboard your luxury railcar for your scenic travel to Anchorage (12:15 pm-8:15 pm) where you'll spend the night.

Friday, May 25, 2012 – Anchorage – Alyeska Resort (Girdwood) – Today you'll travel via the Seward Highway along Cook Inlet – watch for Dall sheep on the rock outcroppings shortly after leaving Anchorage. You'll enjoy a Portage lake cruise and

visit the Begich Boggs Visitor Center en route to your final destination of the day - Alyeska which is a premier spa hotel near the quaint town of Girdwood.

Saturday May 26, 2012 – Alyeska Resort – Today is a day at leisure – be sure to take the optional aerial tramway to the mountaintop for the view and where you can dine at the Seven Glacier Restaurant. Stretch your legs on the high alpine trails or relax in the hotel spa.

Sunday, May 27, 2012 – Alyeska Resort – Seward – Soak up the scenery as you travel via motor coach to Seward where you'll board your ship in time for lunch and an evening sail away. You can spend the afternoon on board or browsing the shops of Seward. Another afternoon option is to add a Kenai Fjords National Park excursion to your vacation. Depart Seward at 8:00 pm.

Monday, May 28, 2012 - Relax and enjoy your day on board cruising the Gulf of Alaska. Simply enjoy the scenery or take advantage of some of the optional ship board activities – try yoga or tai chi, spend some time in the spa, or take a gaming lesson.

Tuesday, May 29, 2012 – Today enjoy the beauty of Glacier Bay National Park's tidewater glaciers, snow-capped mountain ranges, ocean coastlines, and deep fjords from the comfort of your ship. You'll have a National Park Ranger Program on board that includes talks, wildlife spotting and ongoing narration. You'll also be able to listen to a Huna Totem native speaker to learn about the region's cultural and spiritual background.

Wednesday, May 30, 2012 – Haines, AK (6:30 am-9:00 pm) – Today you'll get a glimpse of the history of the gold rush as well as the heritage of the Tlingit Indians. Take an optional shore excursion to the Chilkat Bald Eagle Preserve or board the White Pass Scenic Railway for an unforgettable trip through some of North America's most ruggedly beautiful terrain.

Thursday, May 31, 2012 – Juneau, AK (8:00 am-6:00 pm) – Explore Alaska's capital city on your own or take an optional excursion to see whales, walk on the Mendenhall Glacier, or take a wilderness safari.

Friday, June 1, 2012 – Ketchikan, AK (11:00 am-7:00 pm) – Alaska's "first town" is a mecca for sport fishing! Take an optional fishing excursion to catch that salmon of a lifetime or spend the day aboard the *Aleutian Ballad*, one of the crab fishing boards featured on the *Deadliest Catch*, Season 2. Not interested in fishing – See the Great Alaskan Lumberjack Show, take an optional float plane sighting seeing excursion, bear viewing tour, or enjoy Ketchikan on your own.

Saturday, June 2, 2012 – Inside Passage – Today you'll spend the day cruising the Inside Passage en route to Vancouver, BC. Relax and enjoy the view or take part in some of the ship board activities.

Sunday, June 2, 2012 – Vancouver, BC, Canada – (7:00 am) – Disembark and depart for home.

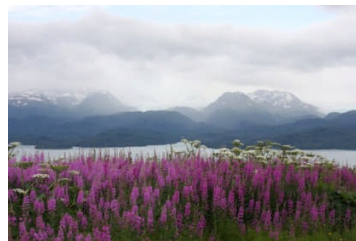
